Dear Fourth Grade Parents/Guardians,

Welcome to the fourth grade family! We will be your child's teachers next year!

English Language Arts, Room 203

Ms. Jones and Mrs. White work together to teach reading and writing. Mrs. White, the ESOL teacher, supports students who are learning English as a second language. In 4th grade ELA, we will read grade-level novels and informational texts. Your child will write narratives, a research paper, opinion papers and work on grammar skills.

Math, Room 206

Mrs. Bell teaches math. In 4th grade, almost everything we work on involves knowing the basic multiplication facts. They will solve problems involving all operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division).

Science and Social Studies, Room 202

Ms. Johnston teaches Science and Social Studies. In Science, we will be studying Energy, Soil, Rocks, and Landforms, and Environments. In Social Studies, we will be learning about Geography, Pennsylvania History, Colonization of Pennsylvania, and Pennsylvania Government.

Summer Work!!!

ELA - Students will receive "I Can Make this Promise" to read over the Summer. We will discuss the novel during the first week of school. For writing, we ask that you have your student write a journal entry at least once a week on any topic of their choice. Each entry should be at least one paragraph (5 sentences) long.

MATH - Practice your multiplication facts all summer. You should have them memorized when we come back to school.

On the next page, you will find a list of supplies your child will need for the 2023-2024 school year.










4th Grade School Supply List – 2023-2024
