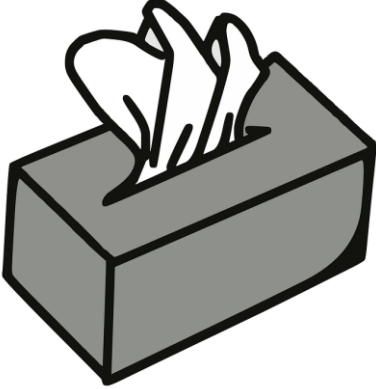

*Mr. Dauria (308) Math:*

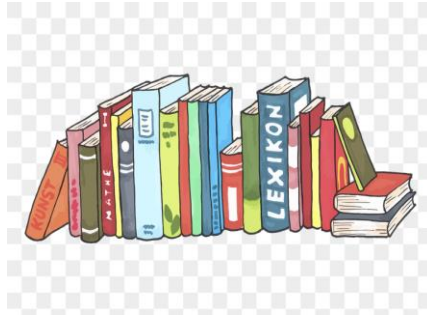
- ❖ 2 notebooks
